Registration of your home / apartment

If you have recently moved to the administrative district of Deggendorf, you and all of your family members have to register at the respective community or town hall.

Your first place-to-go is the local registration office [Einwohnermeldeamt] where you have to register your new residence.

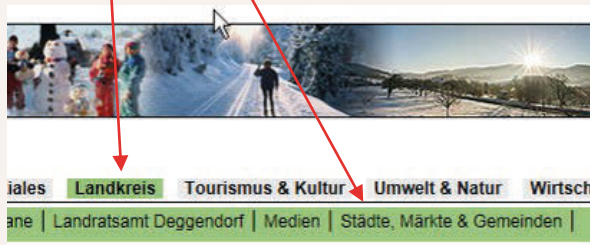
You can get advice and general information about your new home country at the town hall of your community's responsible authority.

Applying for a work and resident permit

Legal information about the alien law can be found on the website of the Bavarian State Ministry of Internal Affairs:

www.stmi.bayern.de

EU citizens do not need a residence permit and therefore don't need to visit the foreigners' registration office.

Non EU citizens need a residence and work permit.

Therefore **your second place-to-go** after your arrival in Deggendorf is the foreigners' registration office [Ausländeramt] to apply for a work and residence permit.
