Corona tests/test obligation

Mobile test centres are currently at your disposal at the Bavarian airports, the main railway stations in Munich and Nuremberg and at motorway service stations near the border. Please also make sure to acquaint yourself with the current regulations concerning the test obligation.

Quarantine obligation upon return from a risk region

Please note that in Bavaria a quarantine obligation exists as a rule after a stay in a corona risk region. This also applies to schoolchildren.

Possible loss of earnings

If you have to go into quarantine for 14 days because of your travel abroad and cannot therefore go to work, the result could be a loss of earnings for which you will not be compensated.
